



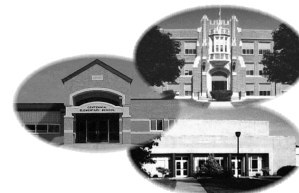

AIMSweb

The academic growth of your child is important to the staff at Centennial Elementary School. To monitor academic progress, your child will be tested in the fall, winter, and spring of each school year.

Starting September 1st we will be testing each child's reading and math skills using a data benchmarking tool called AIMSweb. This system allows you and the teacher to see how your child compares to other children and how fast your child is progressing. The data will help us understand if children are growing academically or if action from our Response to Intervention (RtI) team is necessary.

After testing the RtI team will distribute information indicating how your child performed on the reading and math tests. Children who need remediation will be identified, and parents will be contacted. No Parking Zones

Please notice the additional No Parking Zone near the sidewalk in the front parking lot of Centennial School. This is an important area for handicapped individuals to be able to access in order to enter and exit the building. It is a critically important area for emergency personnel to access in the event of an emergency. The Polo School District works in conjunction with the local fire and police departments to ensure we are providing the safest environment for students, staff and visitors.

PBIS

(Positive Behavior Intervention System)

Centennial Elementary will continue to utilize a school wide positive behavior system this year. PBIS focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior of all students. It is a proactive system approach of prevention and response to classroom and school discipline issues. Emphasis is on developing and maintaining safe environments where teachers can teach and students can learn. School wide expectations are outlined in a Behavioral Matrix, which have been turned into colorful student-friendly posters this year.

We spent the first two full school days teaching children school expectations through COOL TOOLS. Cool Tools are a written, specific plan that each teacher will present as part of the curriculum. The COOL TOOLS will provide direct explanation of each school rule, allow for practicing of each rule, and will give children opportunities to 'role play' each rule. We will continually review and reteach COOL TOOLS throughout the school year.
